In-school barriers <i>(issues to be addressed in school)</i>
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• While progress of PPG eligible pupils was good overall last year, their progress needs to be accelerated further for the current attainment gap in Reading, Writing and Maths to be diminished.• PPG eligible pupils are not achieving Greater Depth Standard in Reading, Writing, EGPS or Maths at the end of Key Stage 2.• High proportion of PPG eligible pupils are also have SEND so further considerations needed when planning for their provision.
External barriers <i>(issues also requiring action outside of school or which are related to home life)</i>
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Low attendance of PPG eligible pupils compared to non-disadvantaged peers.• High levels of emotional need and low levels of emotional well-being leading to a lack of resilience and aspiration.• Lack of “life experiences” and exposure to cultural capital in comparison to non-disadvantaged pupils.

Overarching Key Goal: To diminish the disparity between the attainment and progress of disadvantaged and non-disadvantaged pupils.
