

<u>Literacy</u>

We will be reading a range of fiction and nonfiction books about wild and farm animals which also links in with our Science work. We will be writing reports, instructions and stories linked to our theme. We will be starting to learn how to spell some of the Y2 Common Exception Words.

Music

Our music unit this term is all about how to use our voices to make different sounds, focussing on the different sounds instruments can make. We are also lucky enough to be having recorder lessons

<u>History</u>

In history, we will be finding out about The Great Fire of London and discussing the reliability of a range of sources.

We will be learning about how life was different in the past.

Geography

In geography, this term we will be learning about the continents and oceans of the world. With a focus on using maps to identify where they can be found.

Maths

This half term we are splitting numbers up in different ways and understanding what each digit in a number represents.

We will be comparing numbers using the <> = symbols and begin to look at addition using known facts,

Physical Education

This half term we will be improving our skills in dance. The children will learn to sequence movements together and to make a class dance linked to the book "Where the Wild Things Are!"

<u>Science</u>

Our Science unit this term will be Animals and their habitats. We will be exploring habitats and talking about how animals have adapted to their environment. We will learn the seven life processes and create simple food chains.

Computing

This half term we will focusing on Computer Science. We will understand and follow sequences of information called algorithms. We will write our own simple programmes.
