#### Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Our new children will begin to form relationships with the adults and their peers and will learn our nursery rules and boundaries.

We will learn about who helps us and looks after us in school. We will talk about our own families, develop confidence to share our 'Chatter time' within small groups.

We will learn about the rules of the nursery indoors and outdoors, what is right and wrong, rules and boundaries to keep us safe.

### Maths

We will be learning Number songs e.g. 5 Currant Bun, 5 red apples, 5 dancing leaves, using our fingers and props to represent amounts, counting out 5 and changing the amounts. '1 Little Finger', 'One Finger one thumb keep moving'.

We will be learning how to use the maths area resources, and what we can do with them. Our new children will be learning how to use the Maths Area

We will be looking for Shapes all around us, Houses for the Little pigs, three bears, what shapes they are, their own house.

We will be learning and using positional language, Where is the Gingerbread Man, Goldilocks, the big Bad Wolf, the three little pigs.

### Literacy

We will be looking at factual books to find out information about Autumn Season and changes.

We will be reading Traditional Tales, The Gingerbread Man, Goldilocks and the Three Bears, The Three Little Pigs. We will reenact the stories in the puppet theatre.

We will practise writing our name, making a name label for our self portrait. Writing labels for family members.

Model mark- making in different areas, writing a shopping list in the home corner, design in the construction area and write your name.

Drawing and painting self portraits and our family, form circles and lines to create people pictures.

## Communication and Language

We will be welcoming our new children and will be developing good sitting and listening skills through lots of listening and attention activities and games (Letters and Sounds). We will go on Listening Walks outside: what can we hear? ... any sirens? We will play the outdoor 'big ear' listening game.

We will be taking turns to have 'Chatter time' and will be answering questions about our families and who we live with. We will learn different words we can use to ask questions to find out information about their families.

We will be listening to some Traditional Tales, describing character, events and retelling the stories.

We will be baking Gingerbread, learning new vocabulary for ingredients and talking about the order of how we made the Gingerbread.

Autumn vocabulary, colours and change.

Autumn songs to learn and 'All About Me' topic related songs.

### Physical Development

We will be focusing on developing our fine motor skills using colanders with pipe cleaners, spaghetti into tea strainers, and threading activities.

We will be using our fingers as we join in the Dough Disco. We will squidge and squeeze and make marks in the gel pouches and warm up to writing/ mark making - writing our name on our Self portraits. We will form circles and lines to draw people.

We will also be learning how to wash and dry and hands and why and when we need to wash our hands.

We will be developing our Ball Skills - catching a ball/ kicking a ball in the outdoor area. Learning how we use equipment safely and move around others safely.

## Understanding of the World

We will be looking at the features of the outdoor environment and continue to observe the seasonal changes in our Forest School.

We will listen and learn all about each others families and see how we are all different in our topic 'All About Me', who I live with, etc. to talk about in groups and whole class.

We will be learning about Autumn and Harvest.

We will learn to use Simple City program to create our own park by dragging the pen to move objects we see in our outdoor environment.

# Expressive Arts and Design

We will be painting self portraits, people masks, and family pictures. And choose other resources to add to our pictures for hair etc.

We will be creating a junk model house they live in or the three little pigs live in, selecting a range of materials and finding ways we can stick them on and attach things on to boxes etc.

We will explore instruments and how we can change the sounds they make. We will be learning new Harvest and Autumn songs.

We will be imitating roles of the adult in the family home., in our home corner.
