#### No Pens Day

On Wednesday this week we will be joining thousands of other schools and early years settings across the country by getting involved in an exciting one-day event called **No Pens Day Wednesday**. This year the theme is "Show and Tell" and the children will put down their pens as all lessons and activities will have a focus on speaking and understanding skills rather than writing. These skills underpin everything we do (learning, making friends, having good mental health, and ultimately getting a job) and directly affect pupils' education and life chances. Including speaking and understanding skills in a planned and structured way in pupils' education can have a positive impact on their learning and the children will be able to use what they learn from this day throughout the school year.

We now enter the always busy and exciting Christmas period, and our school events start off with the Christmas Fayre after school on Thursday. Thank you so much for all your donations for the raffle, the tombola and the toy stall and thanks to The Friends and the staff team for planning, organising and running this always popular event.
