Literacy We will be writing non-chronological reports linked to our science topic. Explanation texts will be based on evolution and inheritance and nearer to Easter, we will be writing diaries. Persuasion linked to a subject of the children's choice. Our first book is Skellig. We will also be reading Nevermoor: The trials of Morrigan Crowby Jessica Townsend.

Geography After going far afield in Autumn term, we will come back top Salop! The children will be learning about their county and the wonderful place in which they live—looking at physical and human geography. Linked to Darwin's journey.

PHSE Health and Wellbeing—this includes basic first aid, looking after our mental health and emotions. Communicating with friends on line will also be a focus.


