learning and bringing our curriculum to life.

Year 3 had a visit from the Fire Service who taught the children about fire safety and what to do in an emergency situation, before they each enjoyed a tour of the fire engine. The visits from the emergency services did not stop there though, as Reception have been learning about 'People Who Help Us' and so were visited by the police and two paramedics with an ambulance. Thank you to all our visitors.



Year 3's History topic this term is 'Ancient Egypt' and to celebrate they took part in an Egyptian enrichment day, making canopic jars, mummifying tomatoes and learning an Egyptian dance. 

CHILDREN'S MENTAL HEALTH WEEK AND SAFER INTERNET DAY 2024

Children across the school thought really carefully about their right to have their voices heard and it was lovely to see them all expressing themselves on our non-uniform day at the end of the week.

On Safer Internet Day the children were incredibly reflective and able to recognise the dangers we face online and what we can do to keep ourselves safe. Reception read the story of Smartie the Penguin and learned to Stop, Think and Tell if we see anything we are unsure about online. In Year 1 and Year 2 the children read Digiduck and Chicken Clicken, learning how to protect our passwords and personal information and the 'SMART' rules for staying safe. In Key Stage 2, the children were able to recognise and explain all aspects of online safety, including cyberbullying, digital footprints and digital contracts. Our Year 6 children also wrote persuasive letters to you the parents/carers to highlight the importance of online safety and what we can do as adults to support the children. You will have seen one of the letters come home for you to read and we will put a selection on our website – their writing is fantastic!
