<u>Literacy</u>

We will be reading a range of fiction and non-fiction books linked to the Amazon Rainforest in Brazil. We will then be writing stories and information texts about the topic. Children will continue to write using all the skills they have learnt including exciting vocabulary, accurate punctuation and neat, joined handwriting.

<u>Art</u>

This half term in Art we are looking at sculpture.

Starting off small, we will transform found items into something different. We will then use sticks in our own transformation projects.

Religious Education

In our RE lessons the theme is Gospel. The children will be gaining an understanding of how Christians believe Jesus brings good news for all people. For Christians, this good news includes being loved by God, and being forgiven.

<u>Music</u> This term the children will be having recorder lessons as a whole class. They will continue to learn how to read music and will perform together.

Science

In our Science unit this half term, the children will be learning about seeds and bulbs and understanding what a plant needs to grow and be healthy. The children will be planting seeds and predicting the best conditions needed for the plants to survive. They will undertake careful observations, dissections and come to their own conclusions

<u>P.E</u>

The children will be learning skills needed for team games such as throwing, catching and hitting balls. In athletics, children will be preparing for Sports Day by improving their running, throwing and jumping.

Year Two Summer Term I



Maths

In maths this term we will learning to recognise and write fractions of numbers and shape.
