Literacy

We will be reading a range of fiction and nonfiction texts linked to our animal theme. After halfterm, we will be reading books by Oliver Jeffers and using these as a stimulus for our writing.

In our writing we will learn to segment and blend to spell words using our phonic knowledge. We will compose and record sentences linked to our texts.

Art and Design Technology

In Art we will be learning to mix colours and use these to paint farm animals. We will also be learning to print using different materials.

In DT, we will harvest apples from Forest School and use these to make an apple crumble. This will involve chopping the fruit and mixing ingredients. We will also be evaluating and suggesting improvements.

History and Geography

Linked to our Journeys theme, we will be learning about the steam engines and railways. This will include comparing trains old and new.

In Geography, we will learn how to make a daily weather report and use weather symbols. We will also be learning about hot and cold places and where they are located in the World using maps and a globe.

Maths

This term the children will learning about counting, comparing numbers, part whole relationships. They will also be learning about shape and measures.

After half-term, will start to explore addition and number bonds to 10. We will practise these daily to improve fluency.

Physical Education

This term we will be composing a dance to music, linked to our animal theme, based on the story of Peter Rabbit.

We will be working developing our skills in team games.

Year One Autumn Term



Science

Our Science units this term will be Seasonal Changes and Animals including Humans. We will enjoy spotting the signs of autumn in our beautiful school grounds.

We will be learning about the parts of the body and our senses. The children will look at different types of animals, body coverings and adaptation.

Computing/Music

In ICT we will learn some simple programming skills by entering commands to give instructions to a Beebat.

We will be continuing to explore the different elements of music with a focus on rhythm and pulse.

We will listen to a variety of music and start to explore how we can produce our own music using un-tuned and tuned percussion instruments.

Religious Education

This term we are learning what Christians believe God is like by studying parables from the New Testament.

After half-term, we will be learning about festivals celebrated by other world faiths and advent.
