

Literacy

We will be reading a range of fiction and non-fiction books about Penguins and Polar Bears. We will be writing stories, information texts and poetry linked to our theme. Children will continue to write different kinds of sentences including questions and exclamations.

Maths

This term the children will be recapping multiplication and concentrating on the 2, 5, 10 and 3 times tables. The children will be learning a variety of methods to add and subtract two 2 digit numbers. Furthermore, the children will be learning to tell the time to the nearest 5 minutes.

Science

Our Science unit this term will be Animals, including humans. We will learn about how humans and other animals need good hygiene and a balanced diet to grow into healthy adults. We will carry out a range of investigations based on exercise and health, collecting and presenting data using graphs and charts.

Art / Design and Technology

Our art unit on sculpture will focus on penguins. We will study a contemporary craftsman to inspire us to create work in 2d and 3d. In DT we will develop skills to prepare fruit and vegetables. We will then use these skills to design, make and evaluate a healthy pizza.

Physical Education

This half term we will be improving our skills in dance and team games. In addition we will be walking, jogging or running a mile at the start of our PE lessons to develop fitness and a healthy lifestyle. Please ensure full PE kit is in school on Tuesdays and Fridays.

Computing

This half term we will focus on the Digital Literacy element of the computing curriculum. We will learn about how to keep safe when using computers at home and at school. We will find out how digital literacy is used at home and in the workplace.

Geography

We will be using globes, maps and atlases to learn the names of the seven continents and the five oceans. We will learn about the habitats of penguins and polar bears and understand the differences between polar and equatorial climates. We will be using the directional language of compass points to describe routes on a map.
